Wyclef Jean- The Carnival Tour

Singer, producer, multi Grammy Award winner Wyclef Jean puts on the show of a lifetime at the famed Tabernacle in Atlanta, Georgia. Since leaving the innovative hip-hop supergroup, The Fugees, Wyclef has become hip-hop's unofficial multicultural conscience; a seemingly omnipresent activist, who has accumulated a prolific set list that defies any one genre and can be best described as "global." Ol' Dirty Bastard- aka Dirt McGirt - Free to Be Dirty Live

Ol' Dirty Bastard, Russell Tyrone Jones, is a founding member of Staten Island's highly influential Wu- Tang Clan crew. His first solo album, Return to the 36 Chambers, featured such tracks as "Brooklyn Zoo", "Cuttin' Headz" and "Snakes" and featured the familiar beats of the Wu-Tang Clan's producer, RZA. He has contributed to other Wu-Tang Clan projects including Pras' 1998 international hit single, "Ghetto Supastar (That Is What You Are)". In September 1999 he released N***a Please.

D-12- Live in Chicago

D12 is a quintet of Detroit based rappers, which includes Bizarre, Swift, Kon Artis, Proof, and Kuniva. This group of childhood friends is widely known for their sharp lyrical content and their funky beats. Their 2001 debut album, Devil's Night, which has sold over four million copies worldwide, included two singles that peaked at #2 or higher on the Billboard Hot Rap Singles chart. One of them, "Purple Pills", also peaked at number three on the USA Top 200 Soundscan Singles Sales chart. Their sophomore album, D-12 World, came three years later and debuted at number one on the Hot 200 Albums chart, selling 544,000 copies in its first week alone, and featured the chart topping hit singles "My Band" and "How Come".

August 10th "Metal Mania"

Velvet Revolver- Live in Houston

A concert that follows the release of their self-titled first album, Velvet Revolver. The five-man powerhouse rock band finally brings something new to the scene. While Velvet Revolver inevitably offers a few echoes of its members' illustrious pasts, their sound is defiantly forward-looking and truly fresh. The band features Guns N' Roses founding members Slash and Duff, as well as Stone Temple Pilots vocalist Scott Weiland.

Godsmack- Changes

Changes is the powerful new live concert film from hard rock band Godsmack directed by Daniel E. \ Catullo III and shot with 14 cameras, during their 2003-2004 "Faceless" Tour. The film offers live performances of some of their biggest hits including "Straight Out of Line," "Awake," "Faceless" and many more.

Poison- Live, Raw, & Uncut

Performing at the Woodruff Center with extraordinary guests, The Atlanta Youth Symphony Orchestra, the band pleases the audience with new songs from their May 2005 release, From the Ground Up plus all their greatest hits including "Gel," "Shine," World I Know," and "December" among others.

Styx, veterans of nearly 35 years of performing, join forces with Cleveland's Contemporary Youth Orchestra to perform a range of selections from the Styx catalog.

Robin Gibb- With The Frankfurt Neue Philharmonic Orchestra Live
